**Release, Waiver and Assumption of Risk:** I hereby agree that if I am accepted as a volunteer worker for Austin Wine & Music Festival ("AWMF"), I agree to comply with all of the volunteer policies and procedures which may be established from time to time by AWMF. I understand that failure to comply with the volunteer policies and procedures of AWMF may result in the immediate termination of my volunteer assignments and privileges.

I understand and agree that if accepted as a volunteer, all services performed by me will be performed on a strictly voluntary basis, and that I will receive no remuneration, pay or compensation of any kind, that I will not be an employee of AWMF nor otherwise derive any benefits normally available to employees, and that AWMF shall incur no liability of any nature as a result of my volunteering for AWMF.

I acknowledge that in performing volunteer tasks there exists a risk of injury including physical harm or death, and that all services performed by me will be done at my own risk.
